

English In English, the children use the skills that they develop in Phonics and apply them in their learning. The curriculum is text-led and the children will meet and explore a wide range of exciting books such as 'Jasper's Beanstalk' and 'Stanley's Stick'. A Year One writer should be able to compose sentences, use capital letters and full stops, and use joining words such as <i>and</i>. They should also be able to use spelling rules, for example, adding -ing or -ed to words.		Maths In Maths, children will focus on number and place value, exploring numbers to 20 through counting, grouping, comparing and problem-solving. They will also begin learning about doubling, halving, odd and even numbers. Throughout the year, they will develop their understanding of multiplication, division, fractions, measurement and time, while building confidence with counting and recognising numbers.		
Phonics In Phonics, children learn new sounds, reading and spelling skills, and sentence writing with correct punctuation. Alongside this they are developing fluency whilst talking about what they have read.	Science This term, children will explore everyday materials and their uses, as well as learning about seasonal changes, weather, and animals in autumn and winter.
