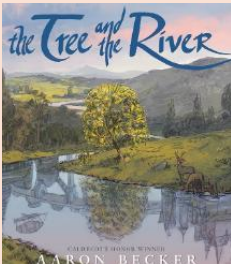
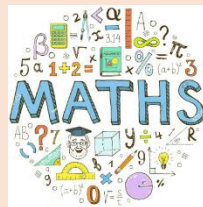


English		Maths		
 In English, we will be starting the term looking at our whole-school picture book 'The Tree and the River' by Aaron Becker where children will use the text as a starting point to develop their writing. Throughout the term, we will use a variety of texts to produce a range of writing, including narratives and non-chronological reports. We will be ensuring that we are exploring, understanding and consolidating our understanding of grammar and punctuation throughout the units of work.		This term we will be focusing on consolidating our understanding of place value with numbers up to ten million. We will also be looking at mental calculation methods; the formal written methods for multiplication and short division; and prime numbers, factors and multiples. We will also look at a new skill this year: calculating the area of triangles and parallelograms. All of our learning will focus on both varied fluency and reasoning and problem solving. 		
MFL During the term the children will consolidate their learning from Year 5. They will learn the vocabulary for classroom items using songs and games. Later in the term we will learn about possessives.	Science Our first unit is Light and Perception, and understanding the science behind how we see. Our second unit is Circulation and Lifestyle. Throughout both units of work, we will be combining theory and practical work and learning through scientific enquiry.	Autumn Term 2026  Year 6 Curriculum	History/Geography In history, we will be using census records to make inferences about the past and about people's lives in different time periods. In geography, we will be examining global patterns by investigating why some places are more densely populated than others.	RE Our topic for the Autumn term is 'Why does religion look different around the world?' We will begin by comparing Abrahamic religions. During the second half term, we will explore the impact that culture, history, geography and tradition have upon religion.
Computing In the first half term, we will explore how computers communicate and how we can work together when in different locations. In the second half term, we will focus on web page creation, whilst considering layout, copyright and hyperlinks.	Music During our first unit – Four-chord pop: Playing in a band – we will combine bass lines, chords, rhythms and harmonies. Our second unit is all about song lyrics and messages. We will analyse song lyrics and write and perform our own verses.	PE Our PE days this term are Tuesday and Friday. Please support your child ensure they have their full PE kit in school. We will start the autumn term by developing skills in tag rugby and hockey. After the half term, we will focus on dance and leadership skills.	PSHE During our PSHE lessons, children will share their hopes and fears and think about our rights and responsibilities. In the second half term we will be 'Celebrating Difference' and how we fit in to the world around us.	Art & Design/Design & Technology In art, we will be developing photography skills and techniques to design a range of creative photographic outcomes. In DT, we will use templates and sewing skills to design and create a book or iPad cover.
